




### PRAYER FOR VOCATIONS

good soil of faithful people.

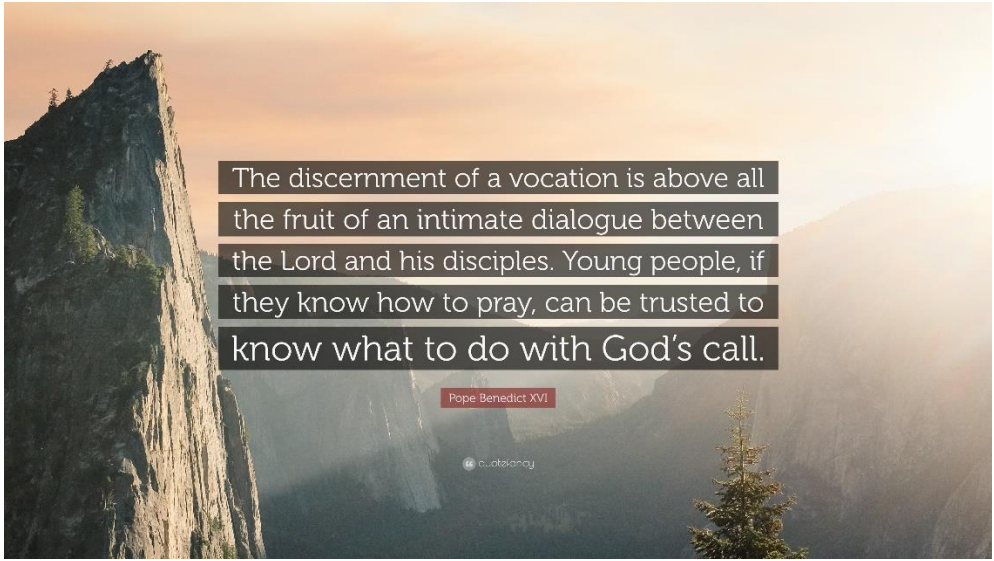
INSTIL those in religious life, parish
